Chair's Report

The 2025 season marked another important step forward for Wests Volleyball Club, with the club proudly fielding two teams — Cosmos and Wolves — in the Canterbury Premier Volleyball League (PVL) with both teams attending the New Zealand Club Nationals.

The PVL remains the region's premier winter competition, bringing together a wide range of athletes from emerging players through to experienced senior competitors across Christchurch. Competing in this environment continues to provide a strong platform for development, performance, and club identity.

Both Cosmos and Wolves committed fully to the PVL season, representing the club with consistency and professionalism throughout the winter competition. Across the season, players demonstrated growth in skill, cohesion, and competitive resilience, reflecting the effort invested in trainings and match play.

A major highlight for the year was the participation of both teams at the New Zealand Club Championships, the pinnacle event for club volleyball in the country. This national tournament brings together leading teams from across New Zealand and represents the highest level of domestic club competition.

Wests achieved a strong national presence in 2025:

- Wolves competed in Division 3, gaining valuable experience against strong opposition and continuing to build as a competitive unit at that level finishing 4th.
- Cosmos delivered an outstanding performance, winning Division 4, a significant achievement that reflects both the capability of the team and the depth developing within the club.

While results are only one measure of success, the exposure to high-level competition at Club Nationals provided invaluable experience for our athletes. Players were challenged against some of the best teams in the country, accelerating development and setting a benchmark for future seasons.

Beyond results, the 2025 season reinforced the foundations of the club:

- A growing player base
- Increased commitment to training and competition
- Stronger alignment across teams under the Wests identity

Importantly, the season also highlighted areas for continued focus, including building depth, improving consistency, and strengthening pathways from development to premier-level play.

The committee extends its thanks to all players, coaches, and supporters who contributed to the season. The commitment shown across both teams reflects a club that is building momentum and establishing itself within the Canterbury volleyball community.

Looking ahead, the focus for 2026 will be on consolidating this progress — strengthening performance in PVL, continuing to support teams to compete at Club Nationals, and building a sustainable platform for long-term success.



Treasurer's Report

Year ending 31 December 2025

This year, the club recorded total revenue of \$10,587.10

- The majority of income came from tournament fees (\$7,065) and competition fees (\$3,522)

Total expenses were \$9,356.39

- The main costs were tournament expenses (\$6,800) and competition costs (\$2,494)

This resulted in a net surplus of \$1,230.71 for the year

As at 31 December 2025, the club holds \$1,230.71 in cash

- The club has no liabilities, meaning it is debt-free
- Total equity sits at \$1,230.71

Summary

- The club is financially stable but operating lean
- Income is heavily reliant on participation (tournaments + comps)
- There are no reserves buffer yet, so future growth or unexpected costs need planning
